Profit and Loss Statement

Treasurer's Report

As many of you have probably suspected, our National Hare & Hound did not have enough participants to break even, let alone make a profit. The club has an overall loss of \$3,804 just for the National Race. We are still waiting for the ambulance refund estimated to be between \$800 and \$1000 which will reduce the loss to around \$2,800. The entire year shows an overall profit of \$2,601 which includes everything (club merchandise sales, race income & loss, dues income, etc).

The club currently has \$11,946.00 in the bank and a lot of merchandise in inventory. If the club is very thrifty and gets LOTS of sponsors for both the night race and the national race, the club should be OK as far as cash flow goes for next year. We must anticipate another low turn out for both of these races due to slow economic times which means outside sponsors is the only way we will be able to break even on races in 2009.

Due to the losses taken on the National Race, the club will not be in a position to purchase Endurocross tickets for the November 2009 race. If club members want to buy tickets for this event and have the same seating section as the 2008 race, the only way to do this is to pay for the tickets before ordering them. The club does not have the money to buy them in advance. If club members are interested in purchasing Endurocross tickets for the November 2009 race, please call or email me so I can get an idea of the cost of each ticket and how many members want tickets in the same area. I am estimating they will be around \$55-60 each. The section will most likely sell out soon so I must have some type of response no later than March 31, 2009 from interested club members. I don't want to see this happen, but if WE don't start picking up more sponsors (\$200 per) to support the races, then the cuts will have to happen.

Possible Cuts:

Enduro Cross: As Mindy stated we are not purchasing enduro cross tickets this year. Its nice to sit next to each other and have a great time as a club, but we lost that ability and buying power

Tent: For the past three years the big top tent was a giant status for us a club within the district. The tent was also perfect for staging our yearly (voting) meeting, club dinner and sponsor displays. Unless our sponsorship increases, the big top will be a thing of the past.

Dinner: During our nation race weekend our last two dinners for our lovely members were FREE! The club paid \$6.50 a person, we were able to feed all of our members, sponsors and family members. Where in the world could you go and have a tri-tip dinner with all the fixings and then come back for seconds, this was all FREE, but at the cost to club.

Club Merchandise: We keep a large inventory of very cool club stuff like shirts, hats, flags, racing jerseys, and jacket.s.,the list can go on and on. Tell me what other desert club has a kick-ass inventory as we do? Really, what other club keeps their members updated in the latest racing fashion? From this point we can't afford purchasing anything to restock our club store or introduce new items. All this inventory is like money sitting right in front of ya but you can't touch it?
