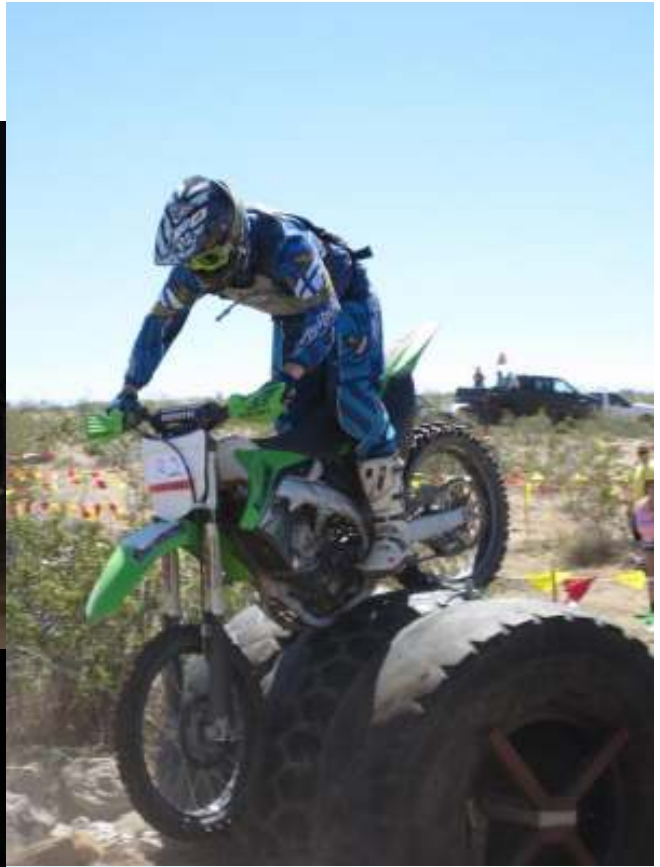
The Best Night Race Ever!
